- (1) The total beneficial ownership includes 15.5794 shares at \$51.9377 per share acquired through dividends paid under the HP Share Ownership Plan ("SOP") on 01/06/10 with respect to shares held under the SOP.

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(2) These shares were held indirectly under the Issuer's 401(k) Plan as of 12/31/09. Fidelity Investments Institutional Services Company, Inc. accounts for holdings in the stock fund in units, comprised of stock and cash reserves. The shares reported represent an approximate value based upon the fund balance and market value of Issuer's common stock.

(3) Each restricted stock unit represents a contingent right to receive one share of HP common stock.

As previously reported, on 01/15/09 the reporting person was granted 6,020 restricted stock units ("RSUs"), 3,010 of which vested on 01/15/10, and 3,010 of which will vest on 01/15/11. Dividend equivalent rights accrue with respect to these RSUs when and as dividends are paid on HP common stock. The number of derivative securities beneficially owned in column 9 includes 9.2296 dividend equivalent rights at \$52.18 per RSU credited to the reporting person's account on 01/06/10, and a de minimus adjustment of .3287 due to fractional rounding of the dividend equivalent rights.

(5) As previously reported, on 12/10/09 the Reporting Person was granted 6,020 restricted stock units ("RSUs"), 3,010 of which will vest on 12/10/10 and 12/10/11. Dividend equivalent rights accrue with respect to these RSUs when and as dividends are paid on HP common stock. The 9.2296 dividend equivalent rights being reported reflect 9.2296 dividend equivalent rights at \$52.18 per RSU credited to the Reporting Person's account on 01/06/10.
