(i) Immediately following the execution of the Securities Purchase Agreement with the Issuer on July 29, 2016 (the SPA) (as disclosed in the Form 8-K filed by the Issuer with the Securities and Exchange Commission on August 1, 2016), each of the Reporting Persons may have been deemed to have beneficial ownership of 916,884 shares of Common Stock, and all such shares of Common Stock in the aggregate represented beneficial ownership of approximately 9.2% of the Common Stock, based on (1) 9,106,240 shares of Common Stock outstanding immediately prior to the execution of the SPA as reported to the Reporting Persons by the Issuer, plus (2) 811,030 shares of Common Stock that were to be issued to Intracoastal at the closing of the transaction contemplated by the SPA. The foregoing excludes: (I) 375,941 shares of Common Stock issuable upon exercise of a warrant held by Intracoastal (the Intracoastal

Warrant) because the Intracoastal Warrant contains a blocker provision under which the holder thereof does not have the right to exercise the Intracoastal Warrant to the extent that such exercise would result in beneficial ownership by the holder thereof, together with the holder s affiliates, and any other persons acting as a group together with the holder or any of the holder s affiliates, of more than 4.99% of the Common Stock and (II) 405,515 shares of Common Stock issuable upon exercise of a warrant that was to be issued to Intracoastal at the closing of the transaction contemplated by the SPA (the Second Intracoastal Warrant) because the Second Intracoastal Warrant contains a blocker provision under which the holder thereof does not have the right to exercise the Second Intracoastal Warrant to the extent that such exercise would result in beneficial ownership by the holder thereof, together with the holder s affiliates, and any other persons acting as a group together with the holder or any of the holder s affiliates, of more than 4.99% of the Common Stock. (ii) As of the close of business on August 5, 2016, each of the Reporting Persons may have been deemed to have beneficial ownership of 625,257 shares of Common Stock, which consisted of (i) 445,405 shares of Common Stock held by Intracoastal and (ii) 179,852 shares of Common Stock issuable upon exercise of the Intracoastal Warrant, and all such shares of Common Stock in the aggregate represent beneficial ownership of approximately 4.99% of the Common Stock, based on (1) 9,106,240 shares of Common Stock outstanding immediately prior to the execution of the SPA as reported to the Reporting Persons by the Issuer, plus (2) 3,244,120 shares of Common Stock that were issued at the closing of the transaction contemplated by the SPA, plus (3) 179,852 shares of Common Stock issuable upon exercise of the Intracoastal Warrant. The foregoing excludes: (I) 196,089 shares of Common Stock issuable upon exercise of the Intracoastal Warrant because the Intracoastal Warrant contains a blocker provision under which the holder thereof does not have the right to exercise the Intracoastal Warrant to the extent that such exercise would result in beneficial ownership by the holder thereof, together with the holder s affiliates, and any other persons acting as a group together with the holder or any of the holder s affiliates, of more than 4.99% of the Common Stock and (II) 405,515 shares of Common Stock issuable upon exercise of the Second Intracoastal Warrant because the Second Intracoastal Warrant contains a blocker provision under which the holder thereof does not have the right to exercise the Second Intracoastal Warrant to the extent that such exercise would result in beneficial ownership by the holder thereof, together with the holder s affiliates, and any other persons acting as a group together with the holder or any of the holder s affiliates, of more than 4.99% of the Common Stock. Without such blocker provisions, each of the Reporting Persons may have been deemed to have beneficial ownership of 1,226,861 shares of Common Stock.
