(1) The reporting person was granted 4,102 shares of Common Stock, issued pursuant to the 2007 RPM International Inc. Restricted Stock Plan.

(2) The reporting person was granted 15,000 shares of Common Stock, issued as Performance Earned Restricted Stock, pursuant to the RPM International Inc. 2004 Omnibus Equity and Incentive Plan.

(3) On July 19, 2013, 25,000 shares of Common Stock issued to the reporting person as Performance Earned Restricted Stock pursuant to the RPM International Inc. 2004 Omnibus Equity and Incentive Plan (the "Plan") vested. In accordance with the terms of the Plan, the reporting person disposed of 10,169 shares of Common Stock back to the Issuer to satisfy tax obligations of the reporting person.

These Stock Appreciation Rights vest in four equal annual installments commencing one year after the date of grant. These Stock Appreciation Rights were granted between 2006 and 2013 and expire 10 years from the date of grant.
