("Wilkes"), previously held by Península Participações S.A., as a result of the exercise by the AD GROUP of the First Put Option as provided in the Conditional Put Option Agreement entered into on November 27, 2006, and amended on December 16, 2009. As a result thereof, CASINO GROUP became holder of the majority of the voting capital of Wilkes.
