(1) Represents shares earned by the reporting person under the formula-based performance share feature of the Corporation's Long-Term Incentive Plan (a Rule 16b-3 plan).

(2) The reporting person was awarded 66,000 shares of restricted stock under the Long-Term Incentive Plan (a Rule 16b-3 plan) on January 28, 2005. These shares will be distributed to the reporting person on the earlier of the expiration of the restriction period or January 28, 2010.
