On May 14, 2012, DeVry Inc. (“DeVry”) issued a press release announcing that its Board of Directors (the “Board”) had declared a semi-annual dividend on DeVry’s common stock of \$0.15 per share, payable on July 12, 2012, to common stockholders of record as of June 21, 2012. The policy of the Board is that any payment of dividends will be at the discretion of the Board and will be dependent on the earnings and financial requirements of DeVry and other factors as the Board deems relevant.
