#### Item 7.01. Regulation FD Disclosure.

On September 9, 2010, GSI Group Inc. (the <u>Company</u>) announced that it has moved its annual meeting of shareholders to November 23, 2010 from its previously scheduled date of September 30, 2010. The Company expects to set October 18, 2010 as the record date for this meeting. The Company also announced that it expects to file its Annual Report on Form 10-K for the year ended December 31, 2009 and Quarterly Reports on Form 10-Q for the fiscal quarters ended April 3, July 3, and October 2, 2009, on or before October 15, 2010, thereby providing shareholders with 2009 financial information prior to the annual meeting. Additionally, the Company expects to file its Quarterly Reports on Form 10-Q for the fiscal quarters ended April 2, July 2, and October 1, 2010, on or before December 31, 2010.

The Company also announced its bookings for the second quarter of 2010, as well as certain balance sheet information as of the end of the second quarter of 2010 and as of September 3, 2010.

Finally, the Company announced that the Board of Directors (the <u>Board</u>) recently retained the executive recruiting firm Lancor Partners LLC (<u>Lanc</u>or) to assist in identifying and recruiting a permanent Chief Executive Officer for the Company. Lancor will work with the search committee of the Board with the goal of filling this position by year end.
